COMPLETING THE CONNECTION

The Gordie Howe International Bridge project is entering an exciting new stage of construction. You may see the temporary bracing pieces placed in the gap between the Canadian and US bridge decks. These braces are used to help provide measurements for the final, permanent segment that will join the two bridge decks together, which will be placed in June. The final segment is smaller than the other 54 segments that make up the main bridge deck. A multi-step process using jacks and temporary braces helps to align each side of the deck before the final steel girders and concrete pieces are installed. The bridge deck closure is anticipated to take four to six weeks to complete.

Once connected, the main span of the bridge deck will measure 853 metres/0.53 miles between the towers, making it the longest main span of any cable-stayed bridge in North America and the 10th longest cable stay bridge in the world.

After the connection is complete, crews will stress and re-stress the cables that connect the bridge and road decks to the towers. Work will also begin on the installation of electrical and fire suppression systems, a drainage system, barriers, signage, lighting, deck paving and pavement markings.
