

## **Public Information Meetings**

Public Information Meetings will be held on **September 24, 2024**, in Windsor at Mackenzie Hall and on **September 26, 2024**, in Detroit at our Southwest Detroit Community Office. The meetings will provide the latest updates on Canadian and US construction activities and the implementation of the Gordie Howe International Bridge Community Benefits Plan. Presentations will begin at 3:30 p.m. and 5:15 p.m. followed by a question-and-answer session.

Construction of the Broadway Street multi-use path in Windsor is anticipated to begin in fall 2024. Coordination has been undertaken with the City of Windsor and Ontario Ministry of Transportation to identify the preferred location for the path and develop the proposed design.
