Road Closures

Sandwich Street - NEW

- To prepare for future construction activities, underground survey work will be conducted for at least five days starting on October 4, 2021.
- Work will occur between 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. daily on Sandwich Street between John B Avenue westward to the intersection of Sandwich and Broadway. Travelers should be aware of traffic signage, cones, and obey the directions of traffic flaggers.
- Traffic could be reduced to one lane at times.
- Access to businesses will be maintained at all times.

Canadian Port of Entry

- Underground servicing work, slab on grade preparation and stone placement continues for maintenance building
- Excavation, layout, subgrade inspections, building formwork, reinforcing steel and concrete placements continue for main building
- Waterproofing and backfill activities continue for secondary inspection building
- Permanent grade raise and surcharge ongoing in return to USA bridge area and east gateway

Canadian Bridge site

- Concrete and rebar work continue to lift the north and south towers
- Rebar and formwork continue to lift the back span piers
- Temporary H piles on the back span are being completed
- Corbel falsework activities continue
