

DETROIT LOCAL ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

Michigan Interchange activities underway as part of the Gordie Howe International Bridge project include a number of local road improvements:

Reconstruction and realignment of:

- Green Street from I-75 to W. Jefferson Avenue, including a boulevard from the Norfolk Southern Railway to W. Jefferson Avenue (**in progress**)
- Campbell Street from I-75 to W. Jefferson Avenue, including a boulevard from the Norfolk Southern Railway to W. Jefferson Avenue (**complete**)
- Livernois Avenue from I-75 to the dead end, with construction of a cul-de-sac and conversion to 2-way traffic south of Fort Street (**complete**)

Reconstruction and reconfiguration of the following intersections:

- West End Street and Fort Street (**complete**)
- West End Street and W. Jefferson Avenue (**complete**)
- Dearborn Street and W. Jefferson Avenue (**in progress**)
- Clark Street and Fort Street (**complete**)
- Clark Street and W. Jefferson Avenue (**complete**)

Road resurfacing will take place on:

- North and southbound I-75 Service Drives from West End Street to Clark Street (**in progress**)
- Fort Street from Junction Avenue to Green Street (**in progress**)
- Cavalry Street: construction of a new cul-de-sac at the southern terminus (**in progress**)
- W. Jefferson Avenue from Campbell Street to West End Street (**in progress**).

Work is nearing completion along Fort Street, which stretched from Green Street to Junction Avenue and included new bike lanes, sidewalks, road resurfacing and landscaping. Remaining work along this stretch includes road paving at the intersections of Fort Street and Junction Avenue and Fort Street and Green Street. Closures are in place to accommodate work at these two intersections.

Reconstruction work is taking place on Green Street between Melville Street and Fort Street. This work includes reconstruction of two oversized traffic lanes and construction of a multi-use path and sidewalks, including landscaped buffers. This work also includes improvements to the current drainage systems along Green Street. This section of Green Street is fully closed to accommodate this work.

There is also reconstruction and reconfiguration work taking place at the W. Jefferson Avenue and Dearborn Street intersection. Closures are in place to accommodate this work.
