Connectivity and Bridge Infrastructure

- Direct connection between ON Highway 401 to MI Interstate-75
- Six traffic lanes – three US-bound and three Canada-bound
- Ability to convert lanes based on traffic volumes
- Paved shoulders in each direction
- Accommodates cars, pick-up trucks, motorcycles, buses, RVs and vehicles with overhead storage or trailers
- Easy routes to airports, shopping, hospitals, city centres and local businesses
- Toll-free multi-use path for pedestrians or cyclists with connections into adjacent trail networks



Traffic Management Features

- Accurate and reliable route planning information, including:
 - Border wait times
 - Live traffic cameras
 - Weather information
- Network connections with border agencies, road authorities and first responders
- 24/7 on-site traffic and operations management centre
- Traffic and security monitoring of entire site
- Integration and coordination with Michigan and Ontario advance highway advisory systems



Port of Entry (POE) Features

- 24 primary inspection lanes in Canada
 - 12 dedicated to passenger and bus traffic
 - 35 passenger secondary inspection bays
- 36 primary inspection lanes in the US
 - 21 dedicated to passenger and bus traffic
 - 41 passenger secondary inspection bays
- Simple to navigate with separated commercial and passenger lanes
- NEXUS cards accepted
- Designated bus processing area
- Welcoming, modern and sustainable facilities with extensive native landscaping

Toll Collection and Payment Systems

- Toll rates based on vehicle axles and height
- Canadian and US funds accepted
- Payment options: cash, debit/credit, contactless payment and registered customer accounts
- Prepaid accounts offering discounted toll rates with manual and auto-replenishment options
- Accounts connected to RFID tags, NEXUS cards and QR code
- Monthly account statements
- Customer service call centre
