- 2 The Breakaway tag is read at toll collection lanes



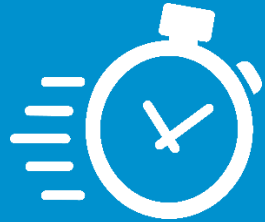

Small and Medium Sized Personal Vehicles Flat Rate

Maximum Height
2.3 metres / 7.5 feet



Small and medium-sized vehicles include most passenger cars, SUVs, minivans, motorcycles and light-duty trucks under 2.3 metres/7.5 feet. A flat rate will be added to the trip if a vehicle is pulling a small trailer with the same Breakaway discount applied.

Large commercial trucks, buses, RVs, vehicles towing fifth wheels and taller passenger vehicles over 2.3 metres/7.5 feet will be charged per axle.

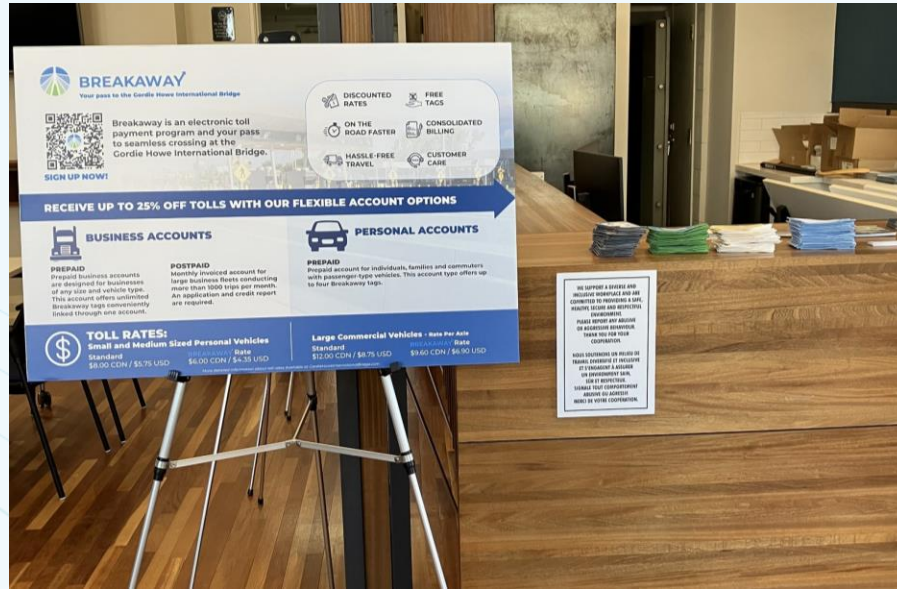
